

**NSS Active Assembly/Region  
Growth Program  
“Extra Effort Awards”**



***Silver Level***

For an “Active” assembly to attain the **SILVER LEVEL**, they must fulfill the NSS Constitutional mandates and achieve a minimum of Fifty (50) points on the “Fraternal Activity Tracking Report”.

Assemblies that achieve the **SILVER LEVEL** will be awarded **\$300.00** for fraternal acts of kindness and support given to their membership and to their communities.

***Platinum Level***

For an “Active” Assembly to attain the **PLATINUM LEVEL**, they must fulfill the NSS Constitutional mandates and achieve a minimum of Seventy-Five (75) points on the “Fraternal Activity Tracking Report”.

Assemblies that achieve the **PLATINUM LEVEL** will be awarded **\$500.00** for fraternal acts of kindness and support given to their membership and to their communities.

***Diamond Level***

For an “Active” Assembly to attain the **DIAMOND LEVEL**, they must fulfill the NSS Constitutional mandates and achieve a minimum of One Hundred (100) points on the “Fraternal Activity Tracking Report”.

Assemblies that achieve the **DIAMOND LEVEL** will be awarded **\$700.00** for fraternal acts of kindness and support given to their membership and to their communities.

***Titanium Level***

For an “Active” Assembly to attain the **TITANIUM LEVEL**, they must fulfill the NSS Constitutional mandates and achieve a minimum of two Hundred (200) points on the “Fraternal Activity Tracking Report”.

Assemblies that achieve the **TITANIUM LEVEL** will be awarded **\$1,000.00** for fraternal acts of kindness and support given to their membership and to their communities.

***NOTE: Assembly approved events, as outlined in the reports submitted by the Assemblies to the Home Office, shall be subject to review by the Executive Officers. The decision of the Executive Officers shall be final in all matters pertaining to this program. All designations and financial awards of the NSS Active Assembly Growth Program will be made by the National Assembly each year during the Spring Board Meeting.***
