

Youth Achievement Nomination Form

Eligibility:

Youth are eligible to be nominated for the award up through and including their eighteenth (18th) birthday, or until they have been selected as the recipient of the award.

Nomination Forms:

Nomination forms can be obtained either from the Home Office or by visiting the official website at www.nsslife.org. To find the forms online, navigate to the section labeled "Fraternal/Forms/Fraternal Program Forms/".

Deadline:

All completed nomination forms must be submitted to the Home Office by April 1st each year. Nominations received after this date will not be considered for that year's award.

Judging:

Once all nominations are received, an independent judge—who is appointed by the NSS President—will review every submission. This judge must be a non-member to ensure impartiality in the selection process. The NSS President, or a designated appointee, is the final authority regarding all aspects and decisions related to this fraternal benefit. No appeals of the judge's decision will be considered beyond this point.

Award:

The youth selected will receive a monetary prize of \$500.00. The winner's name will be announced in both the "National News" and as an insert in the "Youth Circle Magazine." Additionally, the winner's name will be permanently displayed on a commemorative plaque located in the Home Office.
